



## Scholarships for Music Classes

Kindermusik Academy is offering Scholarships to families in which one or both parents have lost a full-time job, in classes in Chesterfield, Des Peres and Richmond Heights. Once-a-week classes are for babies and children up to seven years with an adult. Families in need are offered FREE tuition with payment only for materials. There may be some free materials available also.

When a parent's job is lost, all-important enrichment programs are often not affordable. In order to ensure that more children can participate, and to bring more joy into their lives, Kindermusik Academy of St. Louis is offering scholarships for Summer and Fall 2010 classes. Kindermusik Academy has been providing music and movement programs for 16 years in the St. Louis area.

Summer Camp begins June 16 and tuition averages \$100 for a 5-week once-per-week program. The fall semester begins August 30, for 14 sessions. Kindermusik tuition ranges from \$180 to \$195 for a 14-week program, once per week, with adult and child participation, or \$120 for a 10-week "Family Time" program.

Requirements to obtain a scholarship: the class chosen by the family applying for scholarship must have minimum enrollment of 6 paid-in-full children. Then, scholarships will be awarded about one week before classes begin, and will be on a first-come, first-served basis. The first to apply and show need will be the first to win the scholarships.

If a job is acquired before the semester begins, or during the semester, parents would be expected to contribute payment, or drop off the scholarship list. Parents will be asked to pay for the home materials which give families the complete Kindermusik educational experience by bringing musical activities into the home through books, CDs & instruments. Materials range from \$35 to \$66, and vary with the age of the child and the class in which he or she is enrolled.

Kindermusik is an internationally recognized early childhood music and movement program, developed by Kindermusik International®. It is based on the beliefs that every child thrives and grows through musical endeavors, and that participating with a parent will enhance the bond between them. Children six months through seven years develop life-long musical skills, and love of music through musically-enriching activities, including dance, singing, games, stories, imaginative play and percussion instrument play. High quality home CDs, story books, and instruments keep the music alive at home all week, for further musical enrichment.
